Lake Guntersville State Park is located along the banks of the Tennessee River in NE Alabama. The park overlooks the majestic 69,000 acre Lake Guntersville and features more than 6,000 acres of natural woodlands. The park has a convention center and resort lodge, an 18-hole championship golf course, campgrounds, lakeside cottages, cabins, chalets and miles of nature trails. The convention center has 7 meeting and banquet rooms, including an Executive Boardroom, that offer more than 13,800 square feet of meeting space. The flexible seating arrangements, attentive staff, A/V presentation equipment and breath taking views from the meeting rooms provide the perfect venue for meetings of 10 to 300 people.

The Vantage Group had their first Christmas party at Lake Guntersville in 2008. The party was so successful that the company’s management team decided to use the resort lodge for all of their corporate events. These events require hotel rooms, meals and meeting rooms with presentation equipment. All of these functions involve plans and agendas that can change quickly depending on unforeseen issues. Carty noted, “One year we booked a meeting room and more people than expected showed up. Without hesitation they moved everything to a larger meeting room that was much more comfortable. They just made it happen and took care of us.”

The staff at the resort lodge recognizes the importance of customers and is happy to help them feel comfortable anyway they can. Sandy Tesney, Director of Sales for Lake Guntersville Resort Lodge stated, “We realize that corporate events require a certain level understanding and flexibility. Carty says, “The Christmas party always falls on the SEC Championship game. We just plan it so that everyone can meet in The Hickory Room for the game. It works out great. then make our way to the party. It is great way to make it memorable and we are thinking of ways to use it for our meetings in the future.”

Another great advantage of using Lake Guntersville State Park for business meetings is the variety of outdoor activities. The park consists of thousands of acres and exploring the park can be a great way to spend time between meetings. Bald eagle watching is popular during the winter months at the park.
