1. **Flags may have <u>ANY</u>** design or theme. (Examples: Patriotic, family, favorite animal, Gulf State Park, environmental)

- 2. <u>All materials used must be natural in origin</u>. (Examples: fallen leaves, bark, lichen, rocks, sand, shells, feathers, dead insects, berries). Paint / marker / crayon may be used to add color if desired.
- 3. <u>No living materials may be used.</u> Any animal or plant killed for the construction of the flag will be grounds for disqualification. Lichens and moss may be used. NO GREEN LEAVES OR FLOWERS.
- 4. Poster materials available at Nature Center beginning <u>Saturday</u>, <u>July 1st</u>. Nature Center is open 9 am 4 pm daily. *Glue guns will be available upon request but may not be removed from Nature Center premises*.
- 5. Open to all ages. Families may submit one flag, or individual flags, as desired.
- 6. Flags will be judged on originality, neatness, and use of materials.
- 7. Flags MUST be turned in at the Nature Center in the campground by 3:00 pm on Tuesday, July 4th.
